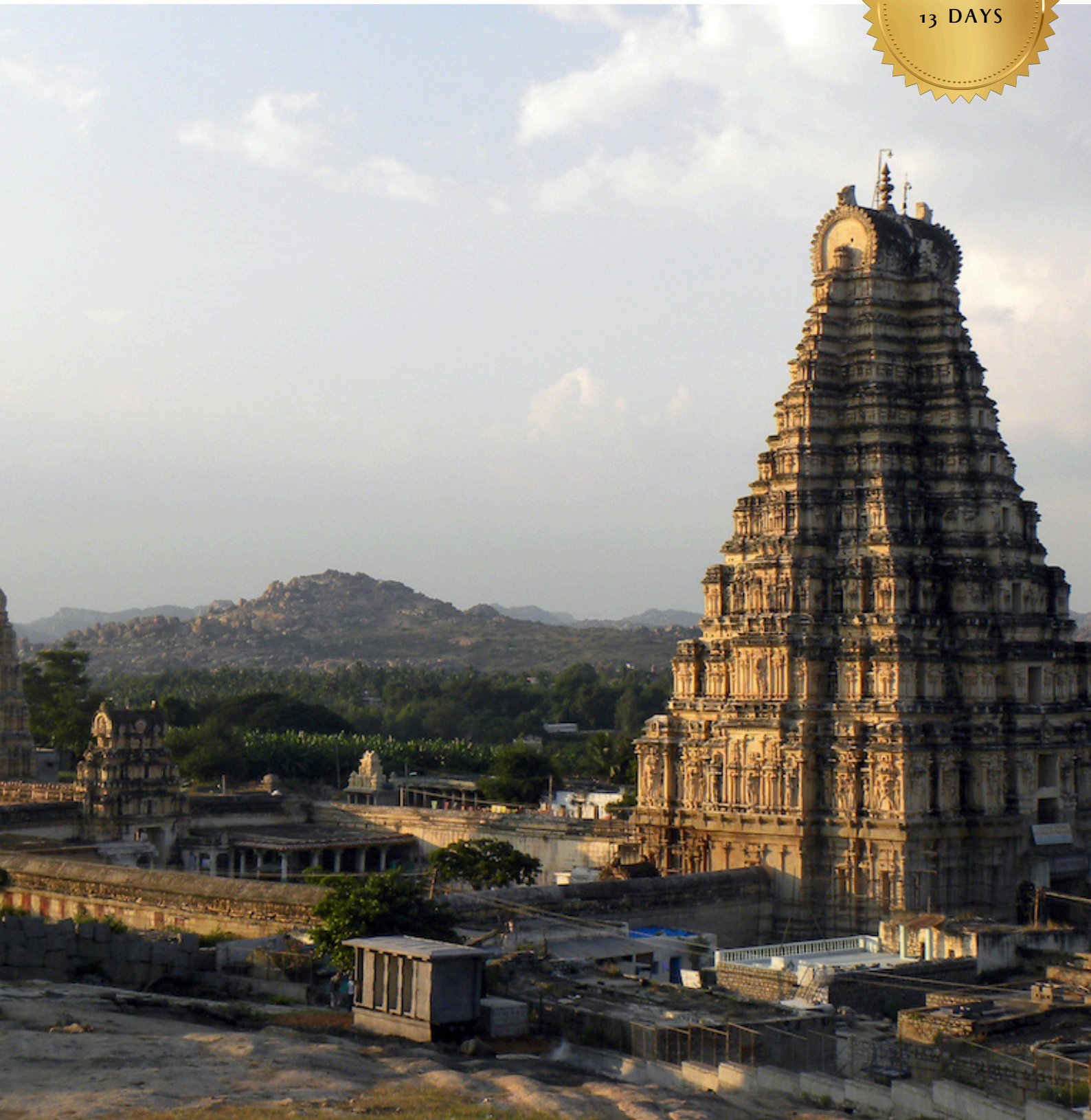

Coorg is a mountainous district in the Indian southern state of Karnataka, approximately 260 kilometers from Bangalore Center and 1,525 meters above sea level. Coorg is often referred to as the Scotland of East by the Scots in British Army, who occupied the area from the 1830s until independence in 1947. The culture, heritage and history of Coorg is deeply intertwined with the Kodava people.
