

JAIPUR | 3 Nights

UDAIPUR | 2 Nights

Udaipur is the City of Lakes! Today's royal lineage stretches back 26 generations, yet even with all its luxurious grandeur, Udaipur has a gentle and relaxing edge. The jewel of the city's crown is sparkling Lake Pichola with the illusory floating Taj Lake Palace, which featured in the 1980s Bond movie, Octopussy.
